Jay Reynolds has been employed as an officer of the City of Troy Police department since 1978, serving in patrol, youth bureau, communications, traffic safety, directed patrol, investigations, court officer and currently assigned as retail liaison in the community services section of the department. Additionally Officer Reynolds is a volunteer fire-fighter at Troy's Station #5 and a hazardous materials technician with the Oakland County Hazmat Response Team.
